Podstawowe informacje o projekcie:

Project Goal: To create conditions for the friendly exchange of initiatives, cultural traditions and national visits between the youth of Ukraine and Poland; to provide for the civil development of the participants in bicultural environment via informal method of theatrical performance.

Project Theme: Development of an inclusive community free from discrimination, prejudice and isolation in regard to the young people who migrate because of military conflicts, economic and social circumstances and have to adapt to a new society. The key issue of the projected dialogue is to find the ways of making the host community a treasury of the European values of understanding, tolerance, self-cognition, integrity, mutual support and multiculturality.

Objectives of the project: creation and realization are fully related to the overall goal and boil down to:

1. Bringing together Ukrainian and Polish young people in Dnipro and building up the space for the open, friendly and active communication on the problems of social adaptation of young migrants in the youth environment;
2. Developing skills of conducting a constructive discussion and self-presentation in bicultural Ukrainian and Polish community;
3. Developing critical thinking, ability to correctly filter social information, to generate ideas and work in a team;
4. Establishing new Ukrainian and Polish contacts between young people for developing and realization of other joint projects in future;
5. Enhancing the level of young people's knowledge of the Ukrainian and Polish cultures;
6. Expanding the participants' ideas about the life of young migrants;
7. Assisting in overcoming inner prejudices and stereotypes related to migrants and finding the ways of their adaptation in the youth environment
8. Analyzing European values of inclusive society as an ultimate guideline of social development

9. Building up skills of identification and settling down interpersonal conflicts that are likely to emerge among young people on the grounds of multiculturalism (cultural otherness);
10. Revealing inner potential of communication with community through live theatrical performance.

What to bring&prepare?

- you will need to create presentation of your country, traditions etc for Polish evening (as interactive as possible, lets avoid boring Power Point presentations)
- bring traditional food and snacks for Polish evening
- prepare presentation as for history and modernity of the Polish theater, renowned buildings of theaters, famous actors, modern trends and plays of the youth theater.
- Don't forget your positive energy, sense of humor and good mood =)
